- The exchange rate you pay will depend on the government's decision to keep or not to keep its own currency.
 - This will affect the nominal and real exchange rates and the cost of an item imported from another country (e.g. New York).
 - The price of this is likely to rise, as you will have to pay more to buy the same item that is imported from elsewhere.
 - An additional inflow of foreign, private or central bank capital will also increase.
 - The international debt repayment Emergency Reserve Fund will receive additional funding from all foreign governments with strong currencies. This could be used to pay back your debts because it is too large to ignore otherwise.
 - The government could begin to import oil rather than buying it from OPEC countries. This would be known as a "breakaway from the Oil Cartel".
 - It would be similar to what happened during the last oil crisis (1973-1974) in the early 1980s.
 - The import taxes are likely to go up to 10% on gas for transportation by pipeline, with many other products.
 - The government would try to ban certain imports and stop imports by companies.
 - The budget would expect that you would be having to pay more for many of your imports as a result of inflation. This would be known as "inflationary import control".
